The aim of the competition is to: inspire and motivate children's artistic creativity and to consciously lead talented preschool-aged children to creative artistic expression; create space where children can express their creativity; to develop the creative skills of pre-school-aged children; give children the opportunity to communicate their experiences and fantasies via artistic expression.

Competition categories: Category I. A: to 5 years of age – kindergartens
Category I. B: to 5 years of age – elementary schools of art
Category II. A: 6 – 7-year-old children – kindergartens
Category II. B: 6 – 7-year-old children – elementary schools of art

I. Competition rounds: The international competition takes place on two levels:
1. regional rounds
2. final round

The organizers of regional rounds need to have delivered the selected artworks for the final round by 10th February 2023 to the address:

In case if in a region the basic district round does not take place, the appropriate enlightenment centre or kindergarten can send their own collection directly to the ŽOS for the final round.

Within the competition, the following succession of events will be carried out:

1. Meeting of the expert jury – 23rd February 2023
2. Selection of works for the colour catalogue
3. Vernissage of the exhibition, announcement of results and awarding ceremony for the authors of the winning artworks: 9th June 2023, 11:00 a.m.

Prizes and certificates: Main prize of the County Chairman of the Trnava Self-Governing Region, JOZEF VISKUPIČ
Prize of the Mayor of Dunajská Streda
Prize of ŽOS
Prize of the Rye Island Museum and other prizes

The expert jury is entitled to award a school or a teacher with the "Prize for a collection of artworks".

II. The artworks sent for the competition must not be presented or enrolled into any other competition; furthermore, they must not be used for other purposes.

Technical conditions: The artworks sent in for the competition must be labeled on the reverse side with the following information (typed, please, not hand-written!): the author's full name, age, the title of the work, and the address of the organization that is sending the artwork in, the teacher's full name (this is important if the artwork is chosen for the exhibition) and their e-mail address (to make our communication easier) as well as the home address of the author. By enrolling into the competition, you are also giving consent for the processing of personal data of the competitor within the meaning of the law No.18/2018 on protection of personal data §13 Article 1 (a) for the needs of ŽOS regarding documentation and medialization of the event.

■ The minimal format of a creative work is A3 ■ Technique: drawing, painting ■ Topic: optional
■ The number of artworks sent in by an organization is not limited ■ One child can send in any number of artworks

DON'T SEND US: ✗ smaller formats (A4, A5) ✗ collages and paste-ups ✗ collective works ✗ works of art school attendees who are already elementary school pupils ✗ Don't post works illustrating cartoon figures from popular cartoons or comic series!

The sent-in works will not be returned to the authors!

III. The Rye Island Enlightenment Centre (ŽOS) as the main administrator and organizer of the competition reserves the right to use the creative works entering the competition for cultural and enlightenment purposes. The participants of the competition voluntarily agree that ŽOS use the copyrights of the contestants without any time or territorial limitation.

IV. The order and material prizes for the selected winners are equal in value. Winners are not distinguished as the first or the next in placement. The prizes for the winning artworks belong to their authors and not to the institutions – i.e. kindergartens, elementary art schools, centers of leisure time etc.
